**APPLICATION FOR ORDER TO ADMINISTER  
PSYCHOACTIVE MEDICATION - FORENSIC**

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Gail Johnson, M.D. (Applicant), files this application, pursuant to Texas Health & Safety Code §574.104, requesting an order to authorize the administration of psychoactive medication to William Maverick Winslow (Patient) and respectfully shows that:

I.

Patient is subject to an order, dated January 9, 2018 for court-ordered mental health services issued under (select one):

- Chapter 46B (Incompetence to Stand Trial) Code of Criminal Procedure
- Chapter 46C (Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity) Code of Criminal Procedure
- Chapter 55, Family Code.

Patient verbally, or by other indication, refuses to take the medication voluntarily.

II.

Applicant has diagnosed Patient with the following mental disorder or mental defect:

**Unspecified Psychosis**

III.

Applicant has determined that administration of the following classes of psychoactive medication marked with an "X" is the proper and customary course of treatment for and in the best interest of Patient:

IV.

The customary and proposed methods for administering the medications are intramuscular injections and oral medications including liquids, pills, tablets, capsules, or dissolving tablets. Applicant will administer the medications in the customary and proposed methods described herein.

V.

Patient presents a danger to Patient or others in the mental health facility, based on the following behavior and/or statements by Patient:

1. **Charged with Aggravated Assault with Deadly Weapon on 9/13/2016 (Knife)**

VI.

Applicant believes Patient lacks the capacity to make a decision regarding administration of psychoactive medication for the following reasons:

**Limited Insight and Limited Judgement**

VII.

Applicant believes that if Patient is treated with the classes of psychoactive medication, specified in paragraph III above, Patient's prognosis is:

**Improved organization of thinking**

VIII.

Applicant believes that if Patient is not administered the classes of psychoactive medication, specified in paragraph III above, the consequences will be:


**Continued lack of progress within hospitalization resulting in a longer hospitalization.**

IX.

Applicant believes: (1) there are no alternative, less intrusive treatments other than treatment with psychoactive medications; (2) there are no alternative, less intrusive treatments that are likely to produce the same results as treatment with psychoactive medications; (3) there are no less intrusive treatments likely to secure the Patient's agreement to take the psychoactive medications; and (4) the benefits of psychoactive medication outweigh the risks of such medication in relation to Patient's present medical condition.

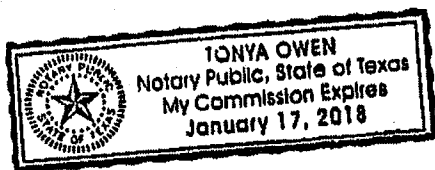
WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Court, upon hearing, enter an order, pursuant to Texas Health & Safety Code §§574.106 and 574.1065, authorizing the administration of the classes of psychoactive medication specified in paragraph III of this Application to Patient in the customary and proposed method, regardless of Patient's refusal.


