Agency, respectively, in the employ of the United

States Government, Department of The Army, Foreign Disclosure Officer, Contracting Officer for the United States of America, CAGE CODE 99994-44200, and Defense Contract Management Agency ID # 15  
E415565. And respectfully moves this Court to accept and file this REPORT, COMPLAINT(S), and REDRESS OF GRIEVANCES, against the Defendants KEN PAXTON, acting in his official capacity as Attorney General for the State of Texas, CO-Conspirator Sharon Wilson, CO-Conspirator Scott Wisch, CO-Conspirator DEEN Anderson, CO-Conspirator Greg Norman, Agent Wu of the Communist People's Republic of China Government, under contract with the Tarrant County Sheriff's Department to provide doctor, psychiatric or psychologist examinations), and medical and psychiatric reports requested by the State of Texas, the District Attorney's office or any of its agents or the Court, due to an irreconcilable conflict of interest, pursuant to Section 4 of Title 18 U.S.C. Aiding and abetting the felony offenses and violations of Federal and State law being committed by Ken Paxton and Co-Conspirators, in violation of Section 3 of Title 18 U.S.C., and in support thereof would show unto the Court as follows:


