(1) The Plaintiff prose, William Maverick Winslow, is a Special Agent with the Defense Security Service, an employee and officer of the Department of the Army, ~~with~~ <sup>assigned</sup> to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, in the official capacity as Delta Force National Nuclear Security Administration's Nuclear Weapons and Special Nuclear Material Security Officer, Federal weapons manager AC56, Classification 94 TOP SECRET security Clearance with Defense Intelligence Agency issued Joint Chiefs of Staff certification, He is the Defense Security Service/U.S. Army - Foreign Disclosure Officer.

(2) The Plaintiff prose, William Maverick Winslow, a Defense Security Service Certified U.S. Army - Foreign Disclosure Officer, is a Director, officer, and registered agent of Maverick Ranch FOUNDATION, INC., a special purpose corporation, duly incorporated and is <sup>in</sup> existence by virtue of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act. The corporation is under reorganization and is to be rehabilitated to operate as a 501(c)(19) tax-exempt organization of the Department of the Army. And further, the Corporation is to be the Title holding company of all Defense Security Service issued Security Agreements pursuant to FORM 441, entered into with all of the Department of Defense Contractors, and General Services Administration Contractors, Department of the Army CASE CODE: 99994 Maverick Ranch Foundation, Inc. CASE CODE: 44440 DEFENSE CONTRACT MANAGEMENT AGENCY ED EU15565

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(3) On or about September 13, 2016, Plaintiff press, an official DSS/U.S. Army business approached an employee of THALLE Company, a Foreign Corporation, doing business as a multinational Government and military Contractor. The Employee was operating a P heavy equipment track shovel at a construction site located at Beach St and Trinity River Bridge. The Plaintiff press, notified the employee that he was with the Defense Security Service, and asked him what he was doing to that specific U.S. Army property. The Employee of THALLE Company kicked the Plaintiff press in the face, striking him in the left cheek and ear. He kicked at his head two more times but missed, due to the fact that ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> Plaintiff press kept moving his head out of the way. Plaintiff press then ~~unloaded~~ <sup>unloaded</sup> a pocket knife in self defense, and the employee of THALLE Company stopped assaulting him, and attempted to cause Plaintiff press imminent danger or serious physical injury.

(4) The City of Fort Worth Police Department agents conspiring with Tarrant County Sheriff's Department agents, and the employee of THALLE Company, lied, ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> falsified, and committed ~~perjury~~ <sup>perjury</sup> in their statements on Police Reports, and Tarrant County District Attorney, and Tarrant County Criminal Court documents. Tarrant County Sheriff Department agent threatened to kill two Tarrant County worker who were present and witness at this activity, if they did



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not lie and falsify their statements made

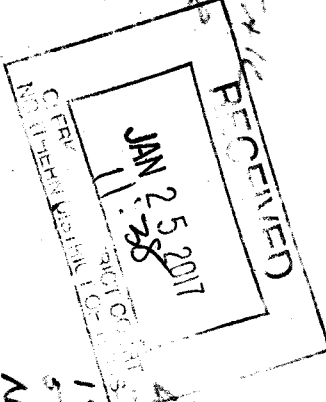

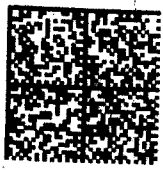
