## ORDER ON REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF INPATIENT COMMITMENT

On the 27th day of May 2021, came on to be considered, pursuant to Article 46B of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure the above numbered and styled cause for a determination of whether the Defendant, WILLIAM MAVERICK WINSLOW, continues to meet the criteria for court-ordered mental health services under Article 46B of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure and whether an order should be issued modifying the Defendant's current commitment from inpatient to outpatient treatment requiring him to participate in a prescribed regimen of medical, psychiatric and psychological care recommended by North Texas State Hospital – Wichita Falls Campus and MHMR Tarrant.

The Defendant appeared through his attorney, Glynis McGinty, and the State appeared through her Assistant District Attorney, Ty Stimpson. An Individual Recovery Plan from North Texas State Hospital – Wichita Falls Campus is on file with the Court.

After considering the request and the Individual Recovery Plan prepared by North Texas State Hospital — Wichita Falls Campus in conjunction with MHMR Tarrant, and there being no objection from either party, the Court GRANTS the facility's request for modification of the Defendant's commitment to outpatient or community-based treatment and supervision and ORDERS that treatment and supervision of the Defendant be provided by Home and Community Based Services and MHMR Tarrant. The Court ORDERS the Defendant to participate in a prescribed regimen of medical, psychiatric, or psychological care or treatment, which includes treatment with psychoactive medication, at the direction of Home and Community Based Services and MHMR Tarrant. More specifically, the Defendant shall participate in and fully comply with any recommended outpatient program established by Home and Community Based Services and MHMR Tarrant and shall take all psychotropic medications as prescribed. The Defendant shall

also follow all recommendations as set forth in the attached Individual Recovery Plan, including participating in cognitive behavior therapy to continue to address any anger management issues.

The Court further ORDERS the Defendant to reside and remain in the group home designated by Home and Community Based Services and/or MHMR Tarrant. The Defendant shall not move from the group home without permission of the Court. Additionally, the Defendant shall abide by all group home rules and the group home curfew. The Defendant shall not leave the group without approval by the group home manager and/or staff or travel to an unapproved location.

The Defendant shall not possess or carry any knife, firearm, club or other weapon. The Defendant shall not use, consume or possess alcohol or illegal drugs or controlled substances. Further, the Defendant shall not have any contact with the alleged victim in the pending case.

It is further ORDERED that North Texas State Hospital – Wichita Falls Campus transition the Defendant to Home and Community Based Services and MHMR Tarrant and transport him to his group home when a bed is available. It is further ORDERED that the Defendant receive court-ordered outpatient or community-based treatment and supervision for a period not to exceed 12 months in order that he may receive mental health services. This Order is subject to renewal.

It is further ORDERED that THE CLERK OF THIS COURT send a copy of this order to counsel for the Defendant, Glynis McGinty, at her current address, counsel for the State of Texas, North Texas State Hospital – Wichita Falls and MHMR Tarrant.
